Bitch should not be overweight when breeding. Exercise daily through most of pregnancy - daily walks, optional treadmill. This is because adipose tissue can affect reproductive function and lead to issues with embryo development. Obesity in dogs is also a major complication when it comes to canine pregnancy. Fat can infiltrate the myometrium (a layer of the uterine wall) and reduce the force of uterine contractions. Another issue is that excess weight can make the physical nature of labor more difficult.

DIET: Nutritional deficiencies in the dam can cause congenital problems such as malformation, problems with the central nervous system and other pathologies in the puppies. Regular high quality until about 2 weeks before whelp date when switch to puppy food and add fatty foods (beaver, chicken backs etc.) Old wives tale regarding peas preventing pregnancy not scientifically proven and debunked by vets. HYDRATION is important (a good idea to invest in a water fountain). DO NOT FEED: Extra calcium (especially well into pregnancy) and lots of Vitamin A (liver, mackerel etc) as this can cause cleft palates and damage fetuses. ADD THE FOLLOWING SUPPLEMENTS (beginning before cycle or at least by 1st blood & continue throughout pregnancy):

- Probiotic
- Fish Oil (salmon)
- Folic Acid
- (In the past we have used Oxymate and then Oxymama to great success)

Pregnancy Timeline	
Days 1-4	Pregnancy starts when the dog ovulates which is called the date of whelping. Dog sperm will reach an ovum on day 4 (48-73 hours). For the first 3 weeks or so of pregnancy you may not notice any symptoms. Bitch may become more affectionate, and she may begin to eat more than usual. Her nipples may enlarge slightly.
Day 7	Embryos will move to the uterine horns
Day 16	Dog embryos embed in the uterus lining
4-5 Weeks	At the end of 1 month (4-5 weeks into pregnancy), a clear mucus vaginal discharge may be noticed. This will continue until your dog gives birth. The vulva will remain swollen. Teats become enlarged, particularly at the nipple base. They also become pinker. Less physical activity (though continue normal exercise and nutrition). Bitch may have what is described as morning sickness. SEE A VET IF YOU NOTICE A LACK OF APETITE ACCOMPANIED BY LETHARGY
Day 22	Dog fetus begins to take shape. Manual palpitation, touching from outside the body, BY EXPERIENCED VET is possible now.
Day 28-30	Ultrasound or Relaxin Blood Test (Ultrasound is best); Testing for the hormone relaxin which is produced when the fertilized egg implants. With small litters (less than 3 puppies) false negative results may occur, hence Ultrasound is more reliable.
Month 2 – Around Day 30-35	You may be able to feel the puppies by touching her belly. You may notice clear, odorless discharge from the vagina. If discharge has a COLOR or an ODOR, consult the vet. Changes in bitch: Weight increases about 20-55%; appetite changes with an increase; increase in urination frequency; behavioral changes
Day 32	The embryo takes shape with the eyelids taking on a distinct shape.
Day 35	Toes become visible. Provide more food to meet increase in appetite. Do not overfeed.
Day 40	Claws take shape
Day 45	Coat and skeleton start to form. Vets recommend that the female gets wormed at this point to avoid passing parasites onto the litter. You will see enlarged and firm abdomen around days 45-50. You will see a decrease in appetite. Offer small meals throughout the day.
Day 49	Prepare whelping box
Day 50	Spot puppy movement in the belly
Day 51	Make up a batch of chicken and noodles and freeze in 2 cup measurements in ziplock freezer bags (for bitch to eat later); Make LIVER WATER (Freeze in ice cube trays)
Month 3	You may see milk (colostrum) when pressure is applied to the nipples.

Week Before - Dam's Temperature

BEGIN TAKING TEMPERATURE several times each day. Record. (Normal temp is 101 F. Change to 97/98 or sudden drop means birth within 12-24 hours.) Consult vet if temp is higher as it could indicate an infection. Beth Ballard: "The bitch's hormones are doing what they do and bitch is getting toward the end so she's uncomfortable and easily too warm because she has several warm bodies in her tummy too."

Day 58	Day 58 is considered full term (although Phyllis Williams and other breeders warn that a C-section just 1 day too early can result in serious birth defects). Start cool mist humidifier in puppy room; warm heating pads, get water loaded into nebulizer/oxygenator; check batteries for flashlight; plug-in adaptil; spray bedding and crate with adaptil before going to vet. Cover whelping box with light blanket (clamp on edges). Double check that everything is working.
Day 59	Bitch will look for a nesting area to give birth. Spend time with her in whelping area.
Day 60 <i>(Not recommended to do earlier, could harm developing fetus)</i>	X-ray (Radiograph) to determine: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Number of puppies (count spines) • Sizes of puppies (measure head and birth canal – make sure they can fit through the birth canal) • Positions (If considering free whelp – look at how pups are lined-up, head size etc.) • Compare the puppy bone brightness with the mother's rib bone brightness.

Clear puppy's airways. KEEP PUPPY WARM. Never feed a cold puppy (this will kill the pup). Always check extremities of pup – if cold, warm-up inside shirt (or place in incubator/puppy warmer). Cover puppies with cloth when nursing to avoid drafts.

Colostrum: Get puppy on teat right away and assist. DO NOT TUBE FEED at vet unless complications. It is important to receive colostrum and subsequent antibodies from the dam within the first 12-18 hours, ideally within 4 hours. DO NOT TUBE FEED at vet unless complications (as soon as food enters puppy's body the gut closes and puppy will not receive colostrum). After initial hours (4, possibly up to 12-18 hours) the puppy can't absorb colostrum. Only tube feed as a last resort if dam is sick or puppy is fading.

Environment: Turn on cool mister – keep air moist. Adaptil diffuser. Room should not be hot – it should be "thermal neutral" which means dam does not have to work to stay warm or keep cold – but have a heat source (heating pad) on bottom of whelping box, and then area where pups can move off.

Initially nurse as much as possible (giving dam potty break etc.) Otherwise, nurse every 90 minutes at minimum, keeping dam separate from pups in b/w feedings. Oversee all feedings (wipe noses if aspirate, take puppy off and suck milk, help eliminate). Place dam on back and build up soft platform with baby blankets for the puppies.

Reiterate: KEEP PUPPY WARM. Never feed a cold puppy (this will kill the pup). Keep puppies in Puppy Warmer (incubator) when not nursing and on dam. Puppies cannot regulate internal temperature. Make sure oxygen tube (with distilled water in oxygenator) is going into incubator/puppy warmer – the puppies need the moisture and O₂. Cover whelping box with sheet so no draft. Keep area contained at first so pups cuddle (or keep in puppy warmer).

Environment: Turn on cool mister – keep air moist. Adaptil diffuser. Room should not be hot – it should be “thermal neutral” which means dam does not have to work to stay warm or keep cold – but have a heat source (heating pad) on bottom of whelping box, and then area where pups can move off.

- Crate-Training starts – nap in crates with comfy beds, start crate games
- CLICKER TRAINING starts as soon as gruel is introduced – learn core skills (attention, manding, come or recall)
- Start working on stacks (floor first, then eventually table) – clicker train/shape

Teach puppy to LOVE having someone take their food, food bowl, toys, bones, and other items to help prevent resource guarding later. While some puppies/mamas wean earlier and are completely weaned by 7 weeks, sometimes this continues. It's all up to the mama.
